

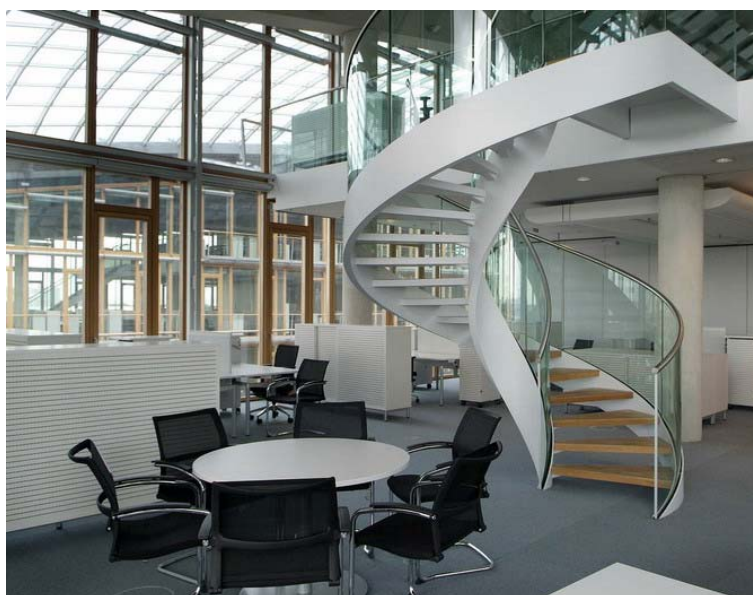

The new administration buildings of Lufthansa are at the heart of Frankfurt airport. Conceived as a low-energy building, the complex consists of five modules, each with seven floors, and a roof in the form of a huge wing. 1800 employees moved into the new, light-filled offices, which are intended to foster and encourage teamwork. "Communication and transparency are the core messages", said architect Christoph Ingenhoven.
