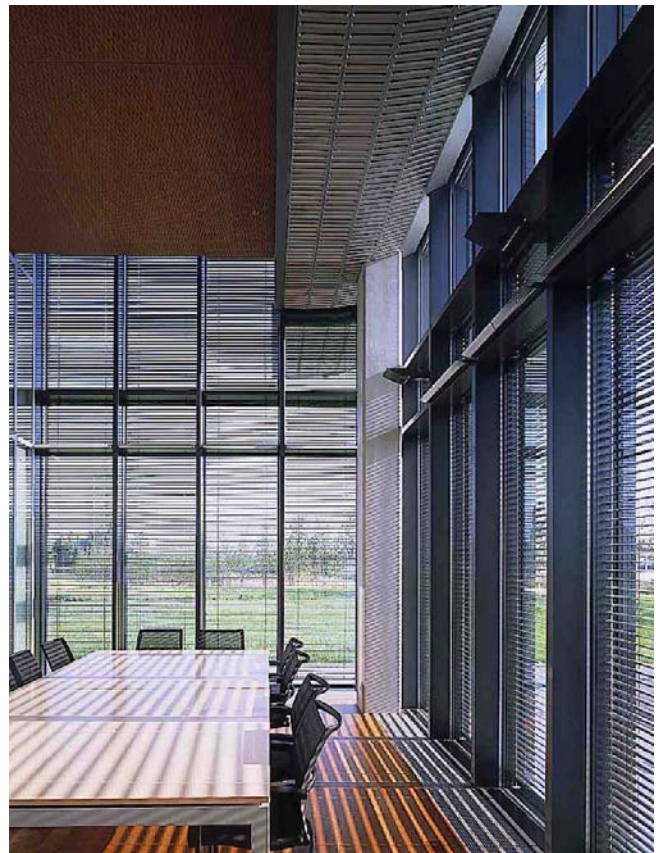

The new manufacturing and administration building of the well-known Swiss watchmaker Vacheron Constantin was constructed on the outskirts of Geneva. The striking building, planned by Bernard Tschumi, houses the administrative sections of the company in the upwardly projecting part. The workshops are located on the elongated ground floor. A shell composed of stainless-steel grids encloses the light-filled, structured monoblock in the middle of a meadow.
