





- personal storage space close to the workstation


The combination of wardrobe elements or shelves and the design options of the front panels turn the locker into an eye-catcher with added value.

In addition to the usual office essentials, it is also possible to store larger items, such as suitcases up to a maximum size of 56 x 45 x 25 cm.




For easy access, door hinges are available on both the left or right

CONFIGURATION AND INSTALLATION

Many modules, many possibilities

The modular lockers are available in four heights and three depths with two different door sizes. The one-door or double-door standard modules can be linked together in any order and offer a wide range of combination options. There are two options for the floor finish: Adjustable glides, which compensate for unevenness, and plinths, which form a flush finish.



Depending on the required use, the lockers are available in three depths

- ① 400 / 500 / 600
- ② 800 / 1000 / 1200
- ③ 436 / 500 / 636

*these compartments are optionally available without a door

¹ with plinth and 25-mm thick top and bottom shelves
(units with glides are 36 mm lower)

Everything stored safely

There are two systems for the lockers: multi-user and private mode. The multi-user mode is suitable for when compartments are only used temporarily, for example, in reception areas or sports facilities. The private mode, on the other hand, is set up for a single user. The locker cabinets are battery-operated and, therefore, independent of the building infrastructure power supply. This also makes moving or rearranging the cabinets an easy task.



Options for lock positions

For better accessibility of the locker, there is an option to place the lock position at different heights, depending on the height of the user. As standard, the locks are always positioned in the centre of the door.

The locks are positioned centrally on all doors


Optimised

- Locks at 1-2 binder heights = lock offset upwards
- Locks at 3 binder height = central
- Locks at 4-5 binder heights = lock offset downwards


Design that fits in perfectly

Whether as a classic storage space, integrated as a room divider or as a creative work tool – the grand slam locker cabinets can be configured according to individual requirements and situations.




Customised surface design

The top, carcass, front and plinth can be designed separately with approx. 40 colours and materials from the Sedus portfolio. This creates a large number of individual combination possibilities.



Letter slot and business card holder

Optionally, it is also possible to configure various designs of letter slots and business card holders (suitable for standard format of 85 x 55 mm).



¹ If a locker with an integrated letterbox slot is selected, the locker is delivered including a shelf, so that documents that are posted in land safely in a separate compartment.

² Only possible for door widths of 500 mm

Numbering

The fronts are numbered with white or black foil stickers. Two sizes and positions are available. The numbering always starts at the top left and proceeds downwards in columns to the bottom right.



Large numbers at the bottom right



Small numbers next to the lock


